Join Grand Prix Chess at Sunday's tournament

Players/Parents can purchase a 2010/11 Grand Prix Chess registration Sunday when signing in for the January 30 scholastic tournament at Edmonton Chess Club. The Grand Prix registration of \$115 (\$105 for players involved in the 2009/10 Grand Prix) will cover the entry fee for the tournament along with 10 other tournaments until next October, including the 2011 Edmonton Regional Challenge and Alberta Challenge. The prepaid entry fees are all discounted and a savings of up to \$55 can be realized in entry fees.

The Grand Prix program also gives out various achievement awards and will hold special events, including on February 10, 7 p.m., at The Roving ChessNuts, an introductory session on the strategy game of "Go" presented by members of the Edmonton Go Association. A spring bowling or Laserquest party will be held just for Grand Prix players, along with some special tournaments.

- **Save up to \$55 on entry fees.** Grand Prix Chess allows Players to receive a \$5 discount on 11 tournaments between January and October 2011, including the Edmonton Regional Challenge and the Alberta Challenge and the Borden Park Outdoor Chess and Family Barbecue. One-year membership in SACK is included if you are not already a member.
- **Grand Prix Chess Players can win certificates, medals and trophies** for various personal chess achievements between October 2010 through September 2011. When you become a Grand Prix member, games you played at SACK tournaments from October 1, 2010 will be included in your personal Grand Prix results.
- **Grand Prix Chess Players will have an opportunity to compete in a special championship series** in different categories of ratings.
- **Grand Prix Chess Players will enjoy at least one special fun event** (last year it was a Laserquest party followed by pizza).
- **Grand Prix Chess Players will have an opportunity to participate in special introductory courses** on other topics (arrangements are being made for the game of "Go" and public speaking)
